

Derrybeg Farm CSA GDPR Policy

Effective Date: 14/11/2023

At Derrybeg Farm CSA, we are committed to ensuring the protection of your personal data and complying with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). This GDPR Policy works in conjunction with our Privacy Notice to clarify how we collect, process, and protect your personal information in accordance with the GDPR.

1. Lawful Basis for Processing:

We will only process your personal data when we have a lawful basis to do so. These lawful bases include the necessity of processing for the performance of a contract, compliance with a legal obligation, protection of vital interests, consent, the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or the exercise of official authority, and legitimate interests pursued by the data controller or a third party.

2. Data Minimisation:

We will only collect and process personal data that is necessary for the purposes for which it is being processed. We will not collect excessive or irrelevant information.

3. Purpose Limitation:

Personal data will be collected for specified, explicit, and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes.

4. Consent:

Where required by law, we will obtain your explicit consent before processing your personal data. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.

5. Data Accuracy:

We will take reasonable steps to ensure that personal data is accurate, complete, and up-todate. If you believe that the information we hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete, you have the right to request its correction.

6. Data Security:

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk of processing your personal data. This includes protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage.

7. Data Subject Rights:

We respect your rights as data subjects under the GDPR, including the right to access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, data portability, and the right to object to processing.

8. Data Breach Notification:

In the event of a data breach that is likely to result in a high risk to your rights and freedoms, we will promptly notify the relevant supervisory authority and, when required, the affected individuals.

9. Data Protection Impact Assessments (DPIAs):

We have determined that it is not necessary to conduct Data Protection Impact Assessments (DPIAs) for our processing activities.

10. Data Transfers:

We do not transfer your personal data outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

11. Changes to this GDPR Policy:

We may update this GDPR Policy from time to time to ensure compliance with changes in regulations and our practices. We encourage you to review this policy periodically.
